We provide confidential, non-judgmental information to people seeking information about travelling to England for an abortion.

ASN was founded by Mara Clarke in October 2009 when we heard from just 4 clients and gave grants totaling £300. ASN has grown and in 2017 we heard from over 1000 clients and gave grants totaling £75k. We've become a critical part of the reproductive health provision in the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland.
