### Fundraising for ASN

ASN is an abortion fund, which means we believe "I can't afford an abortion" should not be the only reason someone becomes a parent. ASN is here to catch those who are unable to access an abortion in their country, and who do not have the financial resources to access one abroad.

No matter what you do, funds you raise will make a huge difference to people who need to travel to access abortion care.

### What a difference your fundraising makes

The money you raise helps us to support people who need to travel for abortion care from the Republic of Ireland, Northern Ireland, Gibraltar, Isle of Man, Malta, and Poland. ASN is a registered charity, providing information, financial assistance, and where needed and when possible, accommodation in volunteer homes to those forced to travel for abortion care. The cost of this generally ranges from £400 to £2,000, and can be more depending on circumstance and stage of pregnancy. Our clients tend to be those who are marginalised and at risk – those in and escaping abusive relationships, people with insecure immigration status, families with pregnancies diagnosed with fatal foetal abnormalities, people who are poor. At ASN we do not ask our clients how they got pregnant or why they want abortions. Our only criteria are financial need and availability of funds.

"I need your help to organise a trip to the Netherlands to have an abortion. I have made this decision after a long time of reflection. My situation is very complicated, I have no support from anyone, I do not have a car and will have to travel by bus or other public transport. I know that after my return I will have to quarantine in Poland. If possible, I would need support to arrange an appointment and an interpreter on site at the clinic. My English language is unfortunately at a basic level. Can you help me?"

#### Be ambitious, but make it doable


Fundraising can be a chance to be creative and have fun, but set a realistic goal.

They set up a Strava group, recruited a group of walkers, and on 11 April set out to walk the 639km, raising an amazing £858 for ASN.

Do you teach a class, and could donate the proceeds to ASN? In 2020 we received over  $\pm 600$  from virtual yoga classes.


### Anna's fundraising story

#### Challenge events

You can usually find events online, or through your local community. Larger cities have running and cycling events each year, or you can set your own challenge (alone or with others).

Events like 10ks and triathlons can be great for fundraising as there's a challenge involved, and great motivation for you.
