Why Fundraise for ASN?

ASN is an abortion fund, which means we believe "I can't afford an abortion" should not be the only reason someone becomes a parent. ASN is here to help those who are unable to access an abortion in their country, and who do not have the financial resources to access one abroad.

No matter what you do, funds you raise will make a huge difference to people who need to travel to access abortion care. In this guide, you'll find hints and tips for getting started with fundraising.

It's been 15 years since we were founded in 2009. Since then, we have heard from nearly 10,000 people, and issued almost £1,500,000 in Grants.

Almost all of our funding comes from donors and fundraisers like you - and without your support, we would not be able to help every person we hear from.

We want to always be able to say 'yes' to someone seeking an abortion, and who needs our help to access it.



The difference your fundraising makes



The money you raise helps us to support people who need to travel for abortion care from the Republic of Ireland, Northern Ireland, Gibraltar, Isle of Man, Malta, Poland, France, Spain and around Europe.

ASN is a registered charity providing information and financial assistance to those forced to travel for abortion care.

The cost of this generally ranges from £400 to £2,000, but can be more depending on circumstance and stage of pregnancy. Our clients are more likely to be those who are marginalised and at risk – those in and escaping abusive relationships, people with insecure immigration status, families with pregnancies diagnosed with fatal foetal abnormalities and people who are poor.

At ASN we do not ask our clients how they got pregnant or why they want abortions. Our only criteria are financial need and availability of funds.

"I need your help to organise a trip to the Netherlands to have an abortion. I have made this decision after a long time of reflection. My situation is very complicated, I have no support from anyone, I do not have a car and will have to travel by bus or other public transport. I know that after my return I will have to quarantine in Poland. If possible, I would need support to arrange an appointment and an interpreter on site at the clinic. My English language is unfortunately at a basic level. Can you help me?" - ASN client we helped in 2020

DO A FUNDRAISING CHALLENGE FOR ASN

There's plenty of ideas on the next two pages, or come up with your own idea and let us know what you're up to!

1. Come up with a fun idea!

You'll get your very own ASN running shirt once you've registered and received your first £25 in donations, for you to wear on the day, and while you're training in the 'run'-up to the big day!



Tips for Setting up and promoting your Fundraising Page!

- 1. Make sure you take a bit of time to personalise your fundraising page and add a bio so people know why you care about ASN this will help to encourage people to donate, and also means people who know you can relate to the page more!
- 2. Add a photo! It's the personal touches that make the most impact.
- 3. Create an acheivable but ambitious target
- 4. If your challenge is an active one, you can link your page to your Strava so your friends and family can keep up with your progress
- 5. Post updates and photos to social media with the link to your page!
- 6. Email your friends, family and colleagues who might not follow you on social media.
- 7. Ask your sponsors to gift aid their donations if they are UK Tax Payers to raise 20% more without lifting a finger!
- 8. If your event is in person, like a gig or a comedy night, you could make a Just Giving page and take donations on the day via a printed QR code to the page! This cuts down on your admin and also means people without cash can still donate.
- 9. Share the link once the event is over! Even if your challenge is done, you can encourage people to donate afterwards you never know, they might have forgotten!
- 10. Even if people can't afford to donate, spreading the word about your fundraiser is a great way to make sure people know what we do, and understand why our work is important!



Tips from a Past Fundraiser

On navigating abortion stigma while you're fundraising!



Fundraising top tips from Jessica, who ran a half marathon for ASN

- "1. Work out how you're going to frame your message. I emailed colleagues and family members to ask for fundraising support thinking carefully about which parts of the ASN message to highlight.
- 2. Don't let the nature of the ASN cause put you off telling as many people that you're fundraising as you would if you were fundraising for e.g. a cancer support charity. This is how we break down taboos.
- 3. If you have an abortion story, decide before you go public with your fundraising if and how you want to share that."



Other ways to fundraise
